In-season photography - A feature for 2016 is the option to select varieties to be photographed throughout the growing season. Photos will be taken five times: the beginning and middle of July and August and once in early September. These photos will be uploaded onto a password protected website for viewing. This new service will come with an additional charge of \$20.00 per entry selected to be photographed. Please indicate on your 2016 trial list which entries you would like to be photographed.

New this year - Designer Pots: A new feature for 2016 is the option to create custom designer combination containers. Each container will consist of 9 annual or perennial plants, and you will specify the arrangement of each plant within the container. When choosing this option, make sure all plants are secured and labeled properly during shipment to ensure proper planting as this is a very delicate process. Please attach arrangement diagram when submitting entry form.

Include a List of Entries - Please send a list of the varieties you are entering that specifies the *desired planting location for each variety*. You should also indicate any special growing requirements for specific varieties, such as sun/shade preference, desired number of PGR treatments for Geraniums (see below), requests to not pinch certain varieties, etc. Plants which have a unique (compact or spreading) growth habit should also be noted on this form. **Please type names of entries as you would like them to be appear in trial displays (trademark symbols, spelling, etc.).** Use the back of this form or attach a list that includes *all requested information*.

PGR Treatments for Geraniums, Petunias and Calibrachoas - For Geraniums, please specify how many applications of Cycocel® each variety is to receive. For petunias and calibrachoas, please specify how many applications of B-9 each variety is to receive. The options are 0, 1 or 2 applications. Our standard treatment for Geraniums is to apply the PGR twice, with about a two week interval between applications. If you do not specify your preference on the list of varieties you include with this entry form, the standard treatment will be applied.

Pinching – Varieties will be pinched as needed for trial uniformity unless otherwise indicated.

New Varieties - If you would like to have your varieties that are new for this year designated as such in our trials, please be sure to include this information in your list of varieties.

Shipment Dates:

ALL SEED should be delivered to CSU no later than **January 31, 2016** (week 4). Please arrange to have **all annual vegetative varieties** delivered to CSU between April 7 and April 18, 2016. (week 15/16)

*We are unable to root cuttings at our University Greenhouse due to our lack of propagation facilities. If at all possible send rooted cuttings. If you are only able to send unrooted cuttings we can work with you to find a rooting station in Colorado.
