# 2014-2015 Cool Season Trial

## Performance Report

Dr. James E. Klett, David Staats and Tom Zimmermann<sup>1</sup>

### Introduction

This is the seventh year that Colorado State University conducted a Cool Season Trial in ground beds. It marks the fifteenth year that Annual Flower Trial Garden is located, adjacent to the Center for the Fine Arts at Colorado State University. The overall goal of this project is to determine which varieties of cool season plants are best suited for marketing and growing in the Rocky Mountain region. Initial data was recorded in October 2014, then approximately every two weeks from February-May 2015 (no data was collected in late December of 2014 and early January 2015 due to snow cover). Irrigation was also monitored throughout this time period and any additional water given to these plants was recorded. This year the cool season trials were evaluated by industry professionals and company representatives on April 29, 2015.

The cool season trials at Colorado State University have no specific operation dollars from state funds. Financial assistance, plant material, and other miscellaneous materials for the trials were acquired from sponsoring seed companies and several Colorado Greenhouse companies. Special thanks to Welby Gardens Inc. for their generous support in growing a flat of each of the cool season varieties. Some operational and staff dollars have come from the Colorado State University Agriculture Experiment Station, Extension, and the Department of Horticulture and Landscape Architecture. Seed companies that participated in this trial were: Benary Seed, Syngenta Flowers, PanAmerican Seed.

### Cultural Data for the 2014-2015 Cool Season Trial Garden

#### PLANTING DATES

All cool season plants were planted on October 3th, 2014. All plants arrived from Welby Gardens as rooted seedlings in cell packs that were 2.25" deep. They were then transplanted into planting beds located in the Annual Flower Trial Garden at 1401 Remington Street. There were 4 plants per cell pack, and 14 cell packs were planted in each row of the beds.

## WATERING

All watering was monitored. Watering was done when natural precipitation was low and when the ground media was not saturated. The winter of 2014-15 had moderate winter precipitation compared to other winters. February was uncharacteristically wet, while March was quite dry. There was consistent snow cover on the beds during late January and the majority of February. The beds were watered using the garden's irrigation system 7 times during establishment month of October. During establishment the entries were watered twice a week due to a warm fall. Fertilizer was injected to the irrigation system four out of the seven watering days during the month of October. A 20-10-20 fertilizer was used. After the garden's irrigation system was winterized in November there were three dates where the entries were watered using a frost free water line. Watering from late-March through May was done with the garden irrigation system. The irrigation system was typically run for 1 hour on a weekly basis. The irrigation system applies .39in of water per hour.

## DATES OF SEVERE WEATHER

Winter temperatures in 2014-2015 were typical of a normal Colorado winter. This year's snow cover occurred from January-mid February. The first hard freezes, (low temps. below 25°F) after the trials were planted, were recorded on October 29th, 2014, when temperature was recorded to be 25 degrees. Extreme cold temperatures are listed in the table below. Wind-chill factors are not included but can be quite significant in Colorado's winter climate. During the second week of November the Front Range of Colorado experienced a severe freeze. Temperatures dropped from above freezing to well below freezing in a matter of hours. During this freeze event there was just enough snow cover to completely cover the entries. Only one out to the 75 cool season trial entries showed damage from this weather event.

### DATA COLLECTION METHODS FROM PLANTING THROUGH EVALUATION DAY

Thomas Zimmermann (undergraduate Environmental Horticulture student) collected data throughout the 2014-15 cool season trial. The data categories collected included: overall rating (1-5), as well as frost dieback ratings as a percentage and percent flower coverage.

The overall rating scoring was: 1=poor condition (dying), 2=weak condition (struggling with some dieback), 3=average (few to no flowers with healthy foliage), 4=good condition (progressing flowers with healthy foliage growth), and 5=great condition (many flowers with healthy uniform foliage growth).

The frost damage/ dieback was based on the number of the all plants per entry row that showed visible frost damage (dead plant material).

The frost damage/ dieback rating was recorded beginning in October of 2014 through mid-April of 2015. Plants were rated as: 1= little dieback to no dieback, 2= some dieback, 3= visible dieback, 4= significant dieback, 5= major frost damage/ plants are dead (all brown).

A record of each entry was taken during the fall months (October-November), as well as in the spring months, (March-April) when each entry 1st bloomed, reached 50% bloom, and when the entry was in 100% bloom. The majority of the entries were received on the 3rd of October already in bloom, those that arrived in bloom were then only recorded when they reached 50% bloom and 100% bloom. Bloom percentage was rated as 1st bloom representing when one bloom was visible on any plant in the variety, 50% bloom representing a variety appeared to average 4 blooms/cell pack, and 100% bloom representing a variety that had full flower coverage.

### **Conclusion**

This year's cool season trials were one of the most successful trials in years. Due to the early planting on October 3rd, 2014, the plant trials were able to establish strong root systems well before the winter. This strong establishment is what is believed to have allowed the plants to perform so well throughout the winter and spring months this year in Colorado. The advisory committee noted how most entries began blooming and performing earlier in the spring and continued their strong performance through spring.

This was also the first year that the majority of the data collection from the spring evaluation day was taken using either a smartphone or a tablet in combination with new wireless internet capabilities out at the trial garden, and a new internet based program developed specifically for the trial gardens. Feedback from the committee members who were involved was positive. The CSU Trial Gardens staff is now working hard to perfect this new evaluation process and prepare for the summer trials. It is worth noting that the new evaluation process has significantly improved efficiency in collecting and tabulating the final data for the cool season trial garden.

## **2014-2015 Cool Season “Best Of” Selections**

### **Best of Show Pansy: Pansy Cool Wave Blue Skies by PanAmerican Seed**

This Pansy began to set itself apart from others early in the trial. It was a vigorous grower with an attractive spreading habit. The blanket of blue and yellow flowers caught people’s eye immediately. Not only was it very attractive, it also had a 100% survival rate throughout the winter.

### **Best Blue/Violet Pansy: Pansy Exp. XXL Denim by Benary**

What made this pansy a winner was the contrasting colors on the large flowers. The flowers were a two toned, iridescent, violet and blue with a very well defined dark blotch.

### **Best Yellow Pansy: Pansy Delta Premium Pure Yellow by Syngenta Flowers**

This vigorous pansy was very uniform in growth. Large yellow flowers were described as having a great depth of color as well as having some darker, contrasting, whiskering, which made this pansy the winner in this category.

### **Best White Pansy: Pansy Delta Premium White with Blotch by Syngenta Flowers**

The blooms on this variety were held well above the foliage as well as being perfectly orientated up. The attractive purple blotch on the flower helped set this pansy apart. A very uniform growth habit only helped solidify it as the top white pansy.

### **Best Novelty Pansy: Pansy Karma Blue Sun by Syngenta Flowers**

The contrasting purple and yellow flowers created a striking appearance, as well as a unique flower color. In addition to the contrasting colors, consistent whiskering helped add even more appeal to the flowers. Judges stated this pansy’s many flowers could be seen from quite a distance.

### **Best of Show Viola: Viola Penny Mickey by Syngenta Flowers**

How could a flower with a Mickey Mouse face not make everyone smile? Judges noted that there was an excellent contrast between the two toned purple and white flower which created a Mickey Mouse like image. The uniform growth habit and countless flowers also made this viola excellent for mass plantings. This viola brought a smile to everyone’s face

**Best Blue/ Violet Viola: Viola Admire Deep Blue by Benary**

This Viola had the deepest blue flower color out of all violas in the trial. Not only was the flower color impressive, the flowers completely covered the plant. This rich blue flower, as well as its uniform growth habit made it an easy winner.

**Best Yellow Viola: Viola Penny Yellow by Syngenta Flowers**

Numerous, electric yellow flowers covered this viola, making it difficult to even see the plant below it. These yellow flowers had consistent dark whiskers that added even to the interest of the flowers. The vigorous growth habit makes it a great selection for large plantings.

**Best White Viola: Viola Endurio White by Syngenta Flowers**

The mounding growth habit and many long lasting flowers gave this viola the edge over other white entries. This combination of an attractive growth habit and many flowers had judges describing this viola a great, full bodied plant.

**Best Novelty Viola: Viola Sorbet Yesterday Today Tomorrow XP by Syngenta Flowers**

A great display of sky blue and white flowers made this a favorite instantly. There were many flowers and the combination of colors was remarkably consistent in every plant. In addition this viola displayed a very uniform growth habit.
