This can help to ensure accuracy and limit the potential for errors entering in hard copy forms.

**There are TWO TABS on the Excel Document Spreadsheet.**

**Tab 1: "Fee Schedule"**. This sheet should automatically calculate the fees for trial entries, based on entry type from the "EntryForm" Sheet.

**Tab 2: "EntryForm"**. This sheet is where you will enter specific trial entries and the information requested below.

**On the "ENTRYFORM" tab spreadsheet, please carefully enter the following:**

**ENTRY NAME:** Include *Genus, specific epithet, variety/cultivar*. \*\*Please note any trademark or registrations

**TRIALING CONDITIONS:** Please "X" the appropriate box(es) for the trialing conditions for **Seed** or **Vegetative** entries under the appropriate **Trial Location (Ground Bed; Container; or Both)** and **Growing Location (Sun, Shade; or Both)**

**STATUS:** If the variety is "NEW" for this year and you would like it designated as such, please indicate.

**VIGOR:** Please note the vigor of the entry (**High, Medium, Low**). This will assist in determining how many plants will be used in the container plantings and for more accurate spacing.

**CLASSIFICATIONS:** Note any specific growth characteristics to align the entry into a particular group.

**OTHER COMMENTS or NOTES:** Any additional concerns that we should be aware of for the entry.

**General Notes about plant growth regulation:** We will pinch or provide PGR applications as needed and on a limited basis.

**\*\*Please Note\*\*** We request that cooperators send rooted cuttings since we are unable to root cuttings at our University Greenhouses due to lack of propagation facilities and space. If you cannot supply rooted cuttings:

**Hardy Boy Plant** (<https://hardyboyplant.com/>) is willing to root liners for the CSU Trial Programs for a fee. Requested ship weeks for URCs (directly to Hardy Boy Plant): Weeks 10, 11, or 12.

**DELIVERY ADDRESS:** CSU Horticulture Center c/o Chad Miller; 1707 Centre Avenue; Fort Collins, CO 80526

**ALL SEED Varieties:** DELIVER to CSU no later than January 10, 2025 (Week 2).

*Sufficient seed should be supplied to obtain at least two 804 flats of plants.*

**ALL VEGETATIVE Varieties:** DELIVER to CSU between April 7 and April 18, 2025. (Week 15/16).

*Sufficient rooted plug/liner numbers required for each variety entered:*

**Ground Trial:** at least 30 plugs/liners per variety

**Container Trial:** at least 10 plugs/liners per variety

**Both Ground and Containers:** at least 40 plugs/liners per variety
